Registration / Abstracts: from 21 August, 2023 to 8 October, 2023

The requirements of the abstract to be submitted are the following:

The abstract should be between 150-200 words in the language used together with five keywords. We recommend that the authors closely follow the substantive and formal guidelines (see Publication guidelines). The abstract of your paper must inform readers about the research you made, as well as the most important results contained in your paper. The main requirement for writing your abstract is that it provides the reader a complete, easily understandable summary of the content of your paper. Furthermore, your abstract should provide efficient information about your paper in such a manner that it raises the interest of colleagues from other areas of research. In short, your abstract should be written in academic style, include a formal indication of the focus of your research, information about the methodology you used and the results obtained.
